At our meeting this month we welcomed Bridget Ambrisco, Director of Volunteer Programs of Cuyahoga Valley National Park Association and John Debo, Chief Development Officer of CVNPA.



They talked to us about the Trails Forever program which is being administered through CVNPA. Trails Forever has five key elements: experiences; volunteer stewardship; planning; trail system enhancement; and endowment. Our club has been and continues to be involved in the volunteer stewardship and planning, and our gift of \$17,500 contributed to the trail system enhancement element.

John expressed CVNPA's gratitude for the donation from our club and that the funds would be used for capital improvements to equestrian trails in the Park. A BIG THANKS goes out to all members that logged and reported their trail miles and saddle hours for 2009.

58 Medina members reported 19,592 trail miles and 4564 saddle hours during 2009. I have been in charge of reporting trail miles for Medina since 2006, and each year, more members have been reporting more miles. This year, almost 5,500 more miles were reported than in 2006. All members that have reported mileage are appreciated. Our governmental agencies have an interest in knowing where we are riding and how much the trails are being used, and the Trail Mileage and Saddle Hours Program gives them the information they need.

New to the report this year was the reporting of saddle hours. Saddle hours and trail mileage are different from each other. Time on the trail is reported as mileage and time in the saddle not on the trail is reported as hours. Reportable trail mileage are miles ridden on trails, i.e. designated park and forest trails, government owned, public and private, in and out of state. Riding in an arena, small field, on a track, or in competition do not qualify as trail mileage but can be reported as saddle hours. Saddle hours include all competing, schooling or pleasure driving. More on the definitions of both categories can be found on the State OHC website page under the Trail Mileage and Saddle Hours Program. I will also be posting a page on Medina’s website with the new definitions. Currently there is a link to an article written by Deb Aldridge on how to calculate your trail miles.

Jack Weese – 732 miles, 7. Kathy Tompkins – 722 miles, 8. Maureen Mizerak – 712 miles, 9. Hank Keys – 700 miles and tied for 10th Lisa Payne and Elena Richenbach, - 690 miles.

How to calculate Trail Mileage ~ Start Keeping track for 2010

Unfortunately, horses don’t come with odometers and no genius has come up with one yet that we know of. The only way to determine miles ridden is to estimate. Good estimating skills come from having accurate references. The best way to obtain that is to ride your horse on several types of trails where you can accurately assess the number of miles ridden. Keep track of the time that it takes you to ride this distance (do not include breaks and the time it may take you to get your horse to cross the water obstacle!). This should help you get a pretty good estimate of your MPH (miles per hour).

Most seasoned trail riders estimate MPH at 2.5 to 5 miles per hour depending on the gait ridden. The typical horse walks at 3-4 MPH, trots at 8-10 MPH and lopes at 10-17MPH. If you have a good mile stretch of area that you can practice the following table will help you estimate your horses MPH.

Minutes to go 1 mile	Speed in MPH
30	2 MPH
20	3 MPH
17	3.5 MPH
15	4 MPH
13	4.5 MPH
12	5 MPH
11	5.5 MPH
10	6 MPH
9	6.5 MPH
8.5	7 MPH
8	7.5 MPH
7.5	8 MPH
6	10 MPH
5	12 MPH

LAW ARTICLE ~ TRUSTS FOR PETS *by Patricia A. Vance, Attorney at Law*

Many people consider their animals, including horses, as part of the family, and at times are given to think about what would happen to my pets, my beloved horse or cat or dog when I die.

From times long ago continuing to the present, animals are considered in the law as property, same as a car, furniture, TV set, etc. you name it.

Nothing in the law in the past prohibited including provisions for the care of animals in wills and trusts. This attorney has used these types of provisions often. However, in view of the historic classification of animals as mere property, greedy heirs occasionally challenged these provisions of the will, arguing, sometimes successfully, that they and not the pets, should receive the money going to the care of the animal.

To eliminate this challenge to wills, Ohio has recently enacted a statute which specifically permits including in trusts and wills provisions for care of animals. As this is now codified law, a challenge by greedy heirs will probably not prevail so long as the documents are properly drafted.

There is no specific "form" for this. The document should be drafted to provide for the particular situation.
