MAY 2011 TRAIL REPORT

Thanks to Mother Nature keeping winter around well into spring, our trail session for April had to be cancelled. There was hope for some dry weather so we could set up some special sessions to get to removing the leaves from some of the trails we did not get to last year.

This month our session is May 21. We will NOT be camping at Robinson for this work session. The field is too wet. Instead, we will gather at Wetmore Trailhead at 8:30 am with Lunch afterwards, We can use all the help! The project is Valley trail from 303 North. We will be fixing some wet areas, removing logs that are blocking water from flowing off the trail and repairing swales. We expect a good turnout of you all, so we can also get ditches and culverts cleared on Wetmore and clear leaves. Although we removed leaves on this one last fall, Mother Nature covered them up again. Doug will be working with us on the 21st. It will be good to see him again.

Trails that have had leaves and ditches cleared are in remarkably good shape in spite of all the rain.

Your committee intends, if Mother Nature permits, to set up some extra sessions to clear ditches and make some other repairs. There is a possibility of having a work session with camping on Memorial Day weekend. We need to catch up on the work sessions since we are behind due to the weather. We will let you know.

Your committee had our quarterly meeting with Bill Zimmer and Norm Rieker on May 3. The Park has plans in June, to begin work on upper Perkins, in the mud areas where riders, in order to try to avoid the mud, are widening the trail to the extent of 40 feet wide in places. It is not the entire trail in this area, but there are there are some places that are bad. Some can be fixed with appropriate swales and others will require hardening.

At our meeting, Bill showed us a brochure for a machine that would be great to use on our trails. We all agreed we would like to have it. The company that sells it had a representative bring one out the next day and demonstrate it. Mike was able to attend. It has a lot of attachments that can be used with it. The price is around \$30,000 for the machine with no attachments. We need to work harder on our fund raisers.

I have now learned that the machine is still here and the Park is renting it! when Bill and Doug I went out to Valley trail on May 12, to scout out the work project for May 21. We discussed looking into the Park working out some sort of longer term rental agreement for this fine machine. Possibly, if the cost is reasonable our club could contribute toward the rent and if the Trails Council is interested, they could do so also. If you were at our last club meeting you had a chance to see the brochure. This is a trac machine. Just the right size for the trail width we like. A lot smaller than the excavator.

Also after our quarterly meeting, Norm Rieker gave us a demo of the motorized wheelbarrow that the Park owns. We may have use for that sometime.

Your trail committee looks forward to seeing all of you out to lend a hand at these trail sessions. We can all take pride in the fantastic trail improvements that we have helped bring about. Our volunteers are held in high regard by our friends at the Park for our hard work and dedication.

And, don't forget, after our regular sessions, all volunteers are treated to a fabulous lunch by our club caterer, Karen Knuth and her able crew!

The dates for the trail work sessions have now been corrected. The correct dates are in your newsletter and on our web site.

DIRECTIONS: From northbound I-271, take Richfield exit, turn right on Brecksville Rd, turn left at light on Wheatley cross I-77 and follow Wheatley to Riverview; From southbound I-271 take 303 East to first light (Peninsula), turn right on Riverview, 5 miles to Ride Headquarters in Howe Meadow. **OR:** from I-77 Use exit 143 (exit is located 23 miles south of Cleveland, 13 miles north of Akron, at I-271 intersection), turn left, go east on Wheatley 2 miles to town of Everett (road ends), turn right (south) on Riverview. Howe Meadow is approximately 1 1/2 miles on the right. **There is a special entrance for BIG RIGS at the FIRST ENTRANCE located north end of the site. Do not try to go up little hill and over tracks...You will get stuck! REMINDER: THESE ARE ACTIVE TRAIN TRACKS!**

The Big Rig entrance will NOT be open on Saturday from 6 am to 1pm, so plan your arrival accordingly!

CAMPING: Semi primitive, pit toilets. Electric is available for a fee. Horse & Human Water is provided.
Stores, motels, restaurants located within 6 miles of the site. Grounds officially open on Friday at 11:00am.
