## NOVEMBER 2011 TRAIL REPORT

This month is our annual joint session with the Trails Council. November 19, 2011. Meet at 9 am at Covered Bridge Parking Lot. Main project is to continue on repairs to Perkins switchback. Over the past few years this has been the main project. Our volunteers did some repair to this area in our August 13 session. It is much improved. See September 2011 newsletter.

Those volunteers not needed on the Perkins project will be removing leaves from the trails on the 19<sup>th</sup>. We have not, as of this writing, yet started on the leaf removal due to lots of rain and due to the leaves have just now started to come down in quantity. We will be setting up some extra sessions to get the leaves before snow. We all appreciated how amazingly dry the trails were this past season in spite of all the rain. We know that a good part of the reason is that they have been cleared of leaves and so are able to dry. The ongoing improvements being made to the trails so the water can run off is also a factor. But, without removing the leaves, they hold water as we all know.

October 8 our volunteers including Hugh Freeman, Roy Hager, Jack Weese, Louise Harting, Roxanne Owens, Larry Owens, Bob Cockfield, Patricia Vance, Rosemary Young, and Sheila Rizer, made several swales in the trail on the hill behind Conway's that should help a lot in stopping the major erosion that was happening there. On the same day, Kathy Cockburn, Sue Bednarski, Bonnie Bennington, Peggy Costic and Erin Campbell cleared some obstructions from the creek crossing at bottom of the hill. Over the past several years people had been building a rock dam in that creek immediately downstream from the crossing. This of course caused the water to back up on to the trail resulting in a muddy approach on the one side. Patricia would tear it down only to find it back up again the next time she was by there. The Park put a sign up warning people not to put obstructions in the creek. The sign seems to have helped. Wayne Crouse cleared a culvert on Wetmore trail.

This month your trail committee will be meeting with the park for our quarterly meeting. We will review this year's projects and outline plans for 2012 projects. Projects that did not get done this year included upper Perkins and the "east" approach to Arizona Bridge. A review of past newsletters for 2011 provide you with an ongoing report on each trail session and all the projects, not to mention the good times had by all!

We continue to have an excellent working relationship with our friends at the Park. They appreciate our hard work and know how and we appreciate their hard work and know how. Together, we get the job done. In spite of "Mother Nature is never gonna let us win!"

When we set up extra sessions we will let you know so if you are available you can be a part of it! Check your email and our web site.

We will have a session to get leaves on Saturday November 12. Meet at 8:30 am at Wetmore trailhead.

November 19, meet at covered bridge. There will not be camping at Robinson. We will have lunch for all our volunteers. Karen Knuth and crew have done an awesome job in the feeding the troops department. Be sure to say thanks.

**You will also be taken off all state and county distribution lists if you do not renew!**

Liability insurance (if you purchase it) becomes effective on January 1, 2012. The policy is with the state and printed copies of the policy as well as insurance cards are not available until 2012.

1. **Fill out the current membership form completely** (legibly, please)
2. Include your e-mail address –makes communication easier and faster!
3. Include your cell phone number (if possible) – this helps us communicate during events
4. **Sign the form! - It will be return if un-signed !!!!**
5. Make your check payable to : **Medina OHC**
6. **Family memberships – Please read as this has changed in recent years!**  
 Family memberships are for spouses or domestic partners one of whom must be 18 years of age or older and their dependants. Dependant means that the spouse or domestic partner contributes greater than 50% of the dependant's support. This is even if the dependant is over 18 years of age.  
 For family memberships that include two adults, **BOTH adults must sign** the form.
7. There is also a type of membership for a single adult with minor children who wishes to get the liability insurance. It is \$50.
8. **Secondary memberships:**  
 Be sure to write "Secondary" across the top of the form. The amount is \$10. You must already be a primary member of another county.  
**Do not include secondary memberships for other counties!** You need to contact that county and fill out their form.
9. **Be sure to check the boxes for Newsletter (mail or website)**
